

Application Process

- 1. Attend an introductory talk or a school tour (see iwshk.org/info for details).
- 2. Submit the **Application** form with documentation and fee. You will receive an automatic email receipt upon submission.
- 3. During the **Interview**, the applicant will be assessed by an Admission Officer in a group setting. A separate appointment will be set with the parents only. The process is designed to assess a child's developmental readiness for the applied class and to evaluate the family's compatibility with Waldorf education.
- 4. Suitable candidates will be extended an **Enrollment Offer** after the interview via email. Please note that acceptance is not guaranteed.
- 5. Accept Offer by signing the reply slip within one week.

How to Submit this Form

In an effort to streamline the application process and to reduce paper use, we respectfully ask that you submit this form on our website.

 - 1. The Application form, filled and saved.
 - 2. The last page of the Application form, printed, signed, then scanned.
 - 3. The applicant's HKID or other travel document.
 - 4. A recent headshot photo of your child.
 - 5. Most recent school report, if applicable, in English or Chinese.
 - 6. Any other educationally relevant reports, such as those describing special educational needs. No portfolio of photo or artwork is necessary.
